



Some pictures from Nanjing. Left are pictures of the Street Market and the Lion's gate. Above is a boat – Wade didn't give me the name of the waterway but it is in Nanjing.





The above pictures are from the Confucius Temple in Nanjing. Wade was allowed to ring the bell which has two tones depending on where it is struck. The tree is in front of the temple and is called a Blessing Tree.



The top two pictures are from a restaurant that they cook at your table. Not sure what it all is but Wade looks very happy with his meal choice. The bottom left picture is of the Dinner entertainment – Se is wearing a traditional costume and playing a stringed instrument.

This is a hot pot in the center of the table. The outer area is filled with oil and various hot peppers, ginger, etc. The inner area is a broth for those who cannot handle the "heat" of what's cooked in the oil. The read cans contain a sauce that you put in your bowl and then create your own dipping sauce by adding crushed garlic, cilantro, onions, etc. When everyone arrives, you order what you want to cook.
